Agreed Order


1. Venue of this cause is hereby changed to Dallas County, Texas for all purposes and all proceedings will be conducted in Dallas County, Texas, subject to the following conditions which conform to the agreement of the parties to change venue:
 - (1) All hearings, except the Final Pretrial Conference and the Trial, if any, on the merits, will be conducted at the Nueces County Courthouse, unless otherwise agreed to by the parties or ordered by the Court;

- (2) All depositions of the parties will be taken in Nueces County, Texas at a mutually agreeable location, unless otherwise agreed to be the parties or ordered by the Court;
- (3) The Honorable Patrick McDowell will remain as the presiding judge of this cause;
- (4) The deadlines and settings contained in the scheduling order signed by this Court on January 22, 2002 will remain in full force and effect and will not be modified, unless otherwise agreed to by the parties or otherwise ordered by the Court;
- (5) The parties have agreed, and it is hereby ORDERED, to take such additional steps as may be administratively necessary to implement the terms of this Order.

2. This Order is binding on all parties to this cause.
